Certificate / result card & Domicile, NOC from candidates other than Lahore board) & 5 sets of F.Sc & Matric result card photocopies. An stamp paper of Rs.50/- for Affidavit bearing text given.
- 3 Students shall pay their dues in the university through Accountant of the Account Office upto **13-11-2018** after obtaining necessary bank challan forms during office hours that is 4:00pm & submit the original paid Bank Challan in the Admission Office after this, their admission will be confirmed / completed (Provisionally).
- 4 Those who do not deposit their dues within this period shall lose their right to admission.
