- 3 Students shall pay their dues in the university through Accountant of the Account Office upto **08-11-2018** after obtaining necessary bank challan forms during office hours that is 4:00pm & submit the original paid Bank Challan in the Admission Office after this, their admission will be confirmed / completed (Provisionally).
